Ms. Jessa's tips and tricks for formal essay writing

- Use rich vocabulary <u>correctly</u>
- Point of view is essential
 - DO NOT USE FIRST OR SECOND PERSON POINT OF VIEW
 - These include *I, me, my, we, our(s), your(s), us, etc.*
 - The universal you is not to be used
- Don't be redundant with your points (this means do not be repetitive or try to say the same thing in many different ways)
- Use relevant information
 - Pick information to include that helps the reader understand your point
- Do not use exclamation points (!), questions (?), useless capitalizations of words or full phrases
- Make sure there is a flow to your writing
 - Do this by ACTUALLY reading your writing!
 - $\circ~$ Have someone you trust read it out loud to you
